Search for Children with Disabilities – Annual Notice

The Garfield Heights City School District seeks to identify, locate and evaluate all children from birth through age 21 who may have a disability.

Disability, in this instance, means such conditions as multiple disabilities, deaf-blindness, hearing impairments, visual impairments, speech and language impairments, orthopedic impairments, emotional disturbance, cognitive disabilities, specific learning disabilities, autism, traumatic brain injury, and other health impairments. Parents may not be aware that their child has a disability or that there are programs and services available.

Parents, relatives, public and private agency employees, and concerned citizens, are asked to help find any child who may have a disability and need special education and related services.
