The major changes from previous years are added COVID expenses and loss of revenue due to the CCBOH attendance mandates. She mentioned awards the programs have won such as the four grand champion awards Express has won in the past four years and the wonderful job our band students do at solo and ensemble competition by receiving ratings of Superior and Outstanding.
