## GARFIELD HEIGHTS CITY SCHOOLS NOTICE OF RIGHTS TO EDUCATIONAL RECORDS

- 1. Parent(s) or eligible students have the right to inspect and review the student's educational record.
- 2. The Garfield Heights City Schools treat student records as non-public except in the following circumstances:
  - a. By prior written consent of the student's parent(s), or by an eligible student
  - b. As directory information
  - c. Under certain limited circumstances
  - d. As permitted by law
- 3. Parent(s) or eligible students have the right to seek to correct parts of the student's education records which he/she believes to be inaccurate, misleading, or in violation of student rights; this right includes a hearing to present evidence that the records should be changed if Garfield Heights City Schools decides not to alter them according to the parent(s) or eligible student's request.
- 4. Any person has the right to file a complaint with the Ohio Department of Education if the Garfield Heights City Schools violate FERPA.
