GHCS to Provide Extended School Year Summer Programs for Students in Grades K-8

As part of the district's strategic plan, and in an effort to provide even more educational enrichment opportunities, along with interactive learning experiences, the Garfield Heights City Schools will be offering summer programming for students in Grades Kindergarten through 8th. Morning sessions will focus on academic enrichment focusing on math and language arts. Afternoons will feature more summer camplike activities, including instructional games, meaningful S.T.E.M. activities and project-based learning opportunities. Breakfast will be available each day, and lunch will be served at 12 noon as well. Specific dates are listed below:

- Session #1: Monday, June 14th through Friday, June 25th with academics from 8:30 a.m. - 11:20 p.m., lunch 12 p.m. - 12:30 p.m., and camp activities 12:30 p.m. - 3:30 p.m. of the session.
- Session #2: Monday, July 12th through Friday, July 23rd with academics from 8:30 a.m. - 11:20 p.m., lunch 12 p.m. - 12:30 p.m., and camp activities 12:30 p.m. - 3:30 p.m. of the session.

Students in Grades Kindergarten through 3rd will participate in this Summer Programming at Elmwood Elementary School. Students in Grades 4th through 8th will participate at the High School. In addition, the High School will be offering credit recovery opportunities over the summer as well. Virtual learning experiences are planned for certain aspects of the Summer Program as well, with details to be shared at a later date. Transportation for students will be supplied for students following normal District protocol, which includes those outside two miles from each building, as always to be adjusted by staffing.
